Qualitative research with current and former porn performers suggests that sexual exploitation and trafficking are common experiences in the porn industry.

Over half of 11 to 16-year-old boys (53%) and over a third of 11 to 16-year-old girls (39%) reported believing that pornography was a realistic depiction of sex, according to a 2016 report.

44.6% of underage sex trafficking victims experienced childhood sexual abuse before entry into the commercial sex industry.

DRUG

Research shows that women are almost always the targets of violence or aggression in porn—about 97% of the time.

Research suggests that frequent porn consumers are less likely to intervene during a sexual assault.

(Foubert & Bridges, 2017; Foubert, Brosi, & Bannon, 2011)



Studies show that people who consume porn frequently are more likely to support sexual violence.



Research has shown that those who don't consume porn report higher relationship quality—on every measure— than those who viewed pornography alone.
