“I was approached at a very vulnerable point in my life. I went back and shot a scene, and it was terrifying and temporarily validating, but afterwards I felt a little empty.”

“[Porn] corporations prey on callow young women and trap them legally into contracts when they’re vulnerable.”

“Even if I fail fighting for my life back, I’m not stopping until I can protect every young girl from getting taken advantage of by these predatory contracts.”
