Sex trafficking shares a variety of symbiotic connections to porn.


Even in the production of mainstream porn, sex trafficking can still occur—and it happens more often than most people think.

Here are a few accounts of actual sex trafficking cases in porn, and what survivors endured while they were exploited for profit.



In 2016, Jane Doe was one of the dozens of women who were sex trafficked by the infamous porn production company, GirlsDoPorn.

We sat down with her and listened to what happened before, during, and after the exploitation and abuse she endured that is still marketed as sexual entertainment today. This is her story:





"WATCHING THE VIDEO NOW, I CAN SEE IT IN MY EYES. THE QUIVERING OF MY LIPS AND MY VOICE, I KNOW **EXACTLY HOW I WAS** FEELING IN THAT MOMENT. BUT TO ANYONE ELSE WHO SEES IT, THEY SEE WHAT THEY WANT AND THEY THINK I WAS COMPLICIT.... [PORN] IS NOT ALWAYS CONSENSUAL. I AM NOT A PORN STAR... I WAS HUMAN TRAFFICKED. AND IT'S NOT OKAY."



By the time she was 14, she had entered into a relationship with a man twice her age who then trafficked her. When she was 18, the exploitation Alia experienced evolved into her joining the porn industry.





Even as a popular mainstream performer, she experienced more trafficking, abuse, and exploitation, eventually breaking free and connecting with other sex industry survivors.

For most of her life, Jessa Dillow Crisp suffered sexual abuse at the hands of her own family members. While she was sex trafficked in her adolescence and adulthood, Jessa was repeatedly filmed with her footage posted to porn sites.

Jessa has since escaped, but the footage of her abuse continues to resurface, even years after working with law enforcement and investigators.




TOGETHER WE CAN #STOPTHEDEMAND
