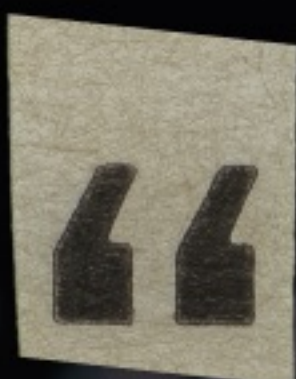


My first porn experience was when I was 12 years old. To this day, I've probably viewed some sort of porn at least once a week for the past six years.
